The Wawa Medical Group consists of six full time positions with the possibility for shared practices if desired. It is essentially a "turn key" operation for the interested physician. The clinic is fortunate to have a general practice surgeon and the position vacant is that of a general practice physician anesthetist. Qualifications in anesthesia or the willingness to pursue a general practice anesthesia designation would be an asset. A second position is opening in June for a general practice/family practice physician. With a six physician and one Nurse Practitioner compliment the members of the Medical Group have ample time for holidays and continuing medical education. There are generous remuneration packages available through the Rural and Northern Physician Group Agreement, Emergency Room sessional fees (Scott Sessional payments) and top up for ER coverage through the Hospital On Call Coverage Program.

The community of Wawa (3700 pop.) is located on the TransCanada highway on the beautiful shores of lake Superior, Wawa lake is located in the heart of the community and your children can walk to sandy beaches in safety during the summer months. Broad stretches of forest lands with rivers and lakes surround the area giving you an opportunity to enjoy such activities as hiking, swimming, cross country skiing, ice fishing, canoeing, hunting and lots and lots of snowmobile trails.

There are English and French language elementary and high schools in the town of Wawa and there are distance education opportunities available through Sault College. There is a new recreation facility in the community with curling, ice hockey as well as a fitness centre. Our air is clean and our streets are safe.

The clinic is housed in the brand new hospital built in 2003, there is also an associated Family Health Team with a Registered Nurse and Nurse Practitioner. The clinic and hospital are also a teaching site for the Northern Ontario School of Medicine. We also welcome medical students from other Universities throughout Ontario and provide practicum experience and teaching for nursing students and students of the medical technologies.
